The trip to Florida was very exciting. We came closer together as a squad. All of our hard work definitely paid off.



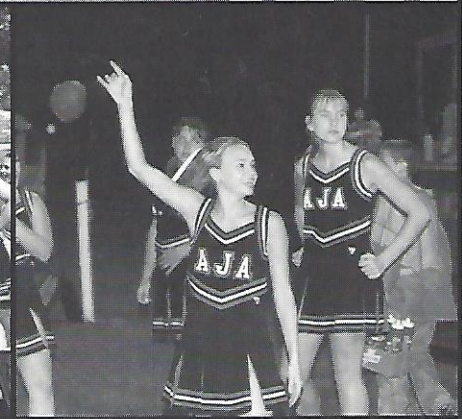
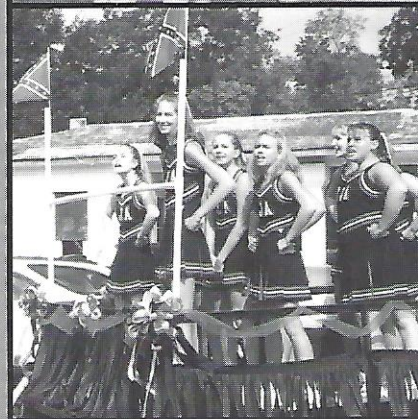
