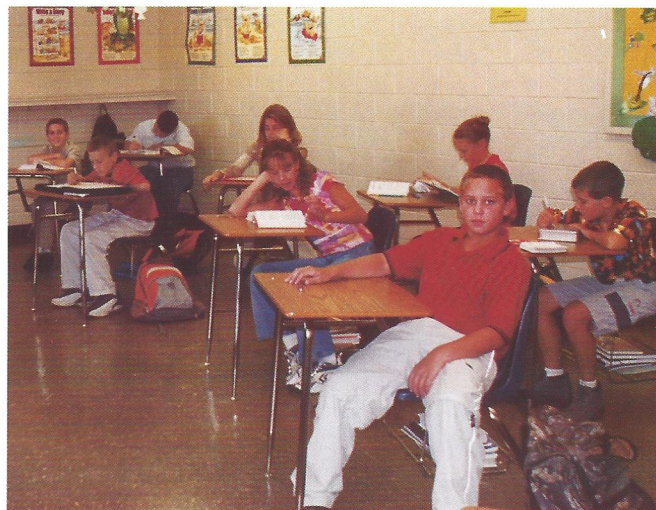
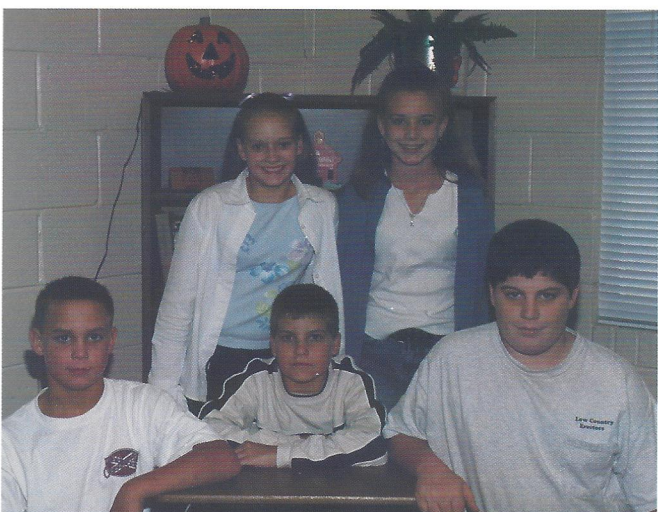


Bryan Bishop is working really hard to complete his vocabulary work.

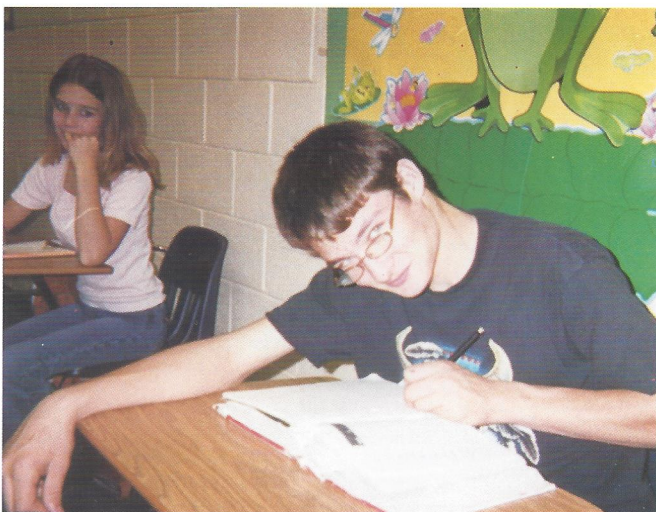
Everyone agrees that Kyle is the class clown. Lauren and Bobby are the quietest.
