

COL. JAMES F. RISHER was born in Hampton County, South Carolina on November 26, 1889. After attending the South Carolina public schools, he completed his formal education at The Citadel in 1911. Eleven years of public school teaching ended in 1922 when he became a teacher at Carlisle. In 1928 Col. Risher became headmaster and thus became a leader in southern military schools.
