TOWARDS TOMORROW

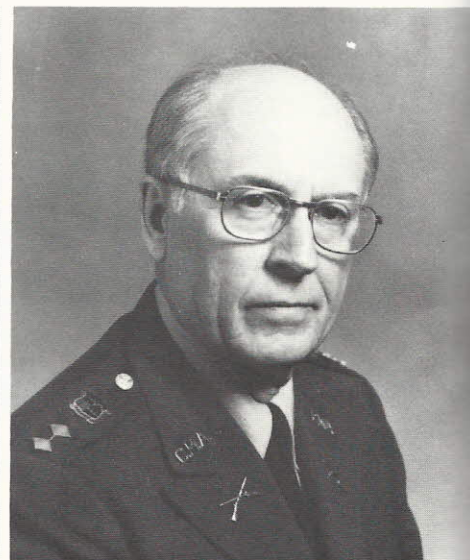

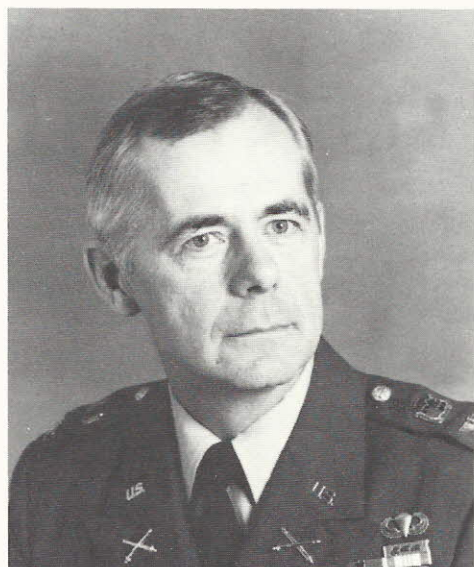
