

GOLD STARS SHINE IN REVIEW

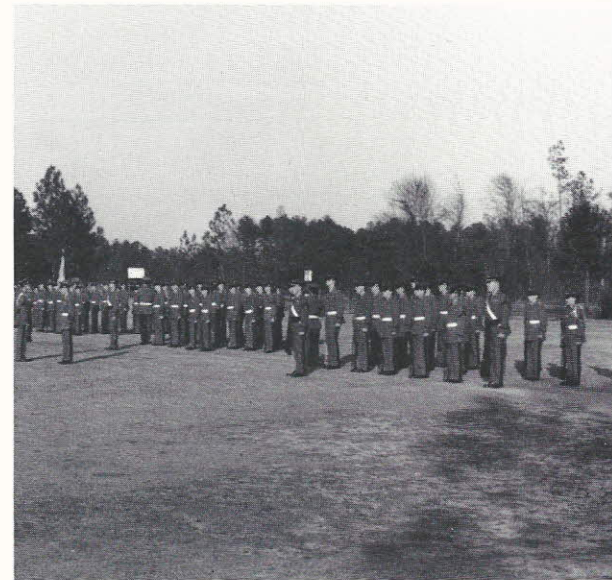


Battalion Commander LTC Brad Nichols, followed by CPT Partida and CPT Dietmeyer, leads the Cadet Corps to the review.
