
A SEASON OF HIGHS AND LOWS

The 1991 football season was sparked by many highs and lows. After a slow but competitive start, the Spartans posted three straight wins. The 1991 schedule was one of the most difficult in years. It featured five play-off teams, including the Public School State Champion, Jonesville; the Independent School State Champion; and the SCNCISAA Dual State Champion. Some of this season's highlights include a state-record-tying 99 yard touchdown pass reception against Defending State Champion, Jonesville; a combined 8 quarterback sacks in a single game by Billy Ray Dial and John Covington; and a 24-0 shutout of conference rival Christ School.
