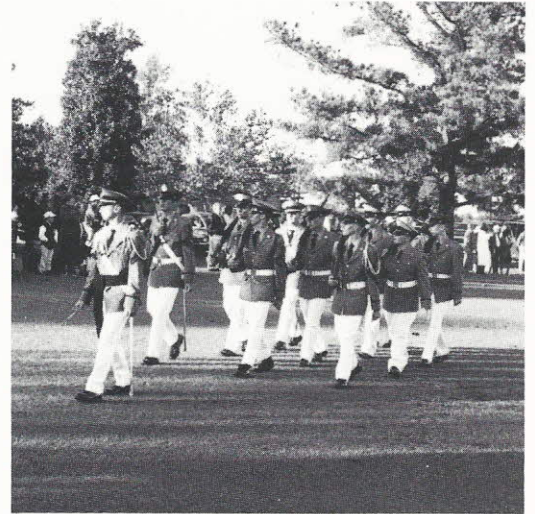


Visitor's Day Parade

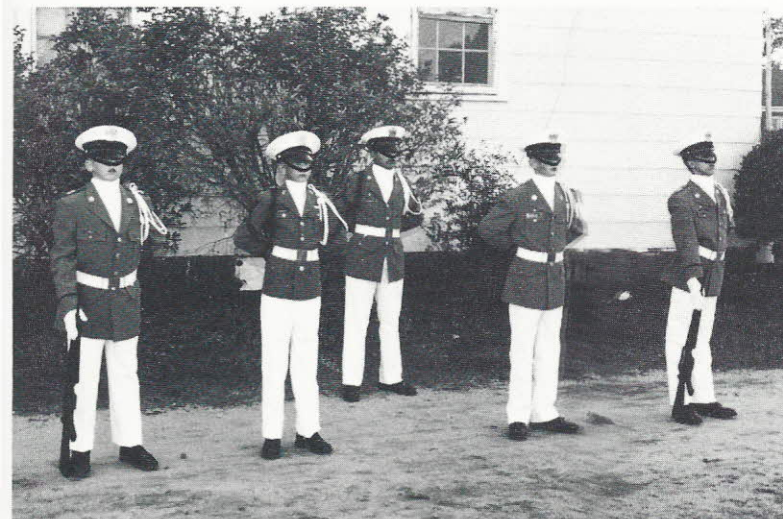
2LT Brian Scalise and the Band and Staff Second Platoon march by the reviewing stand.
