

Varsity Basketball

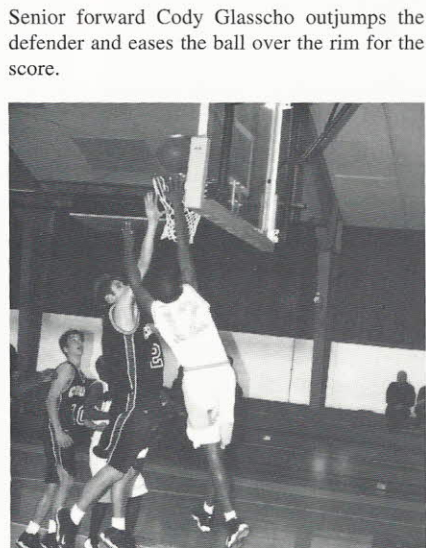

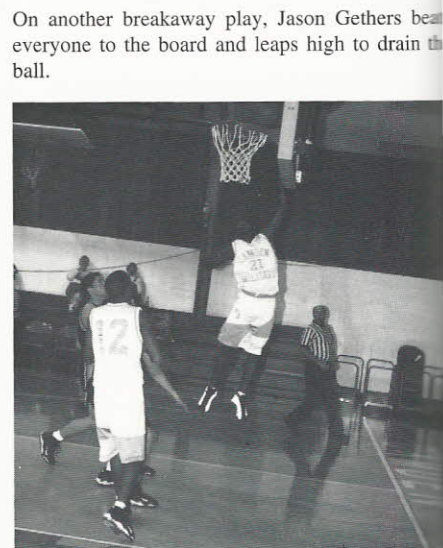
Junior guard Charles Hartley launches a jumper from outside the circle.
