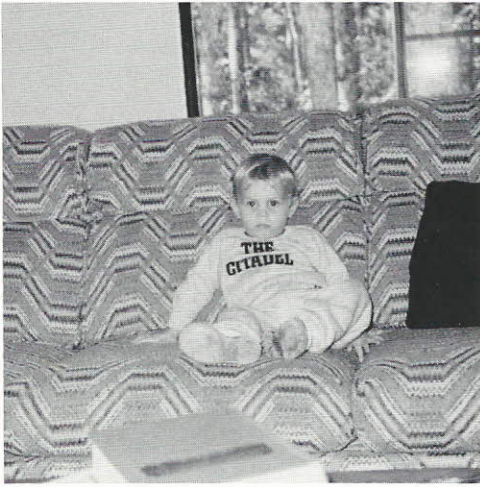


Roy Walter Smith II

For four years we have ridden the waves with you--through good times and bad. We struggled with our decision and ached to have you at

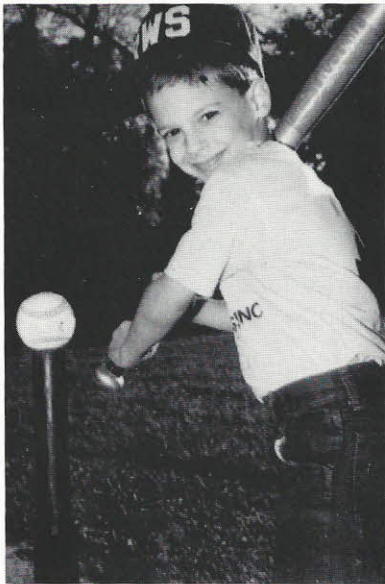
