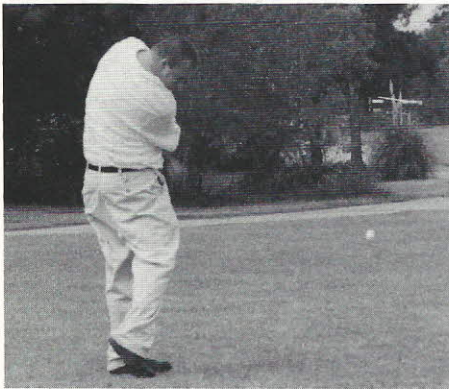


Golf

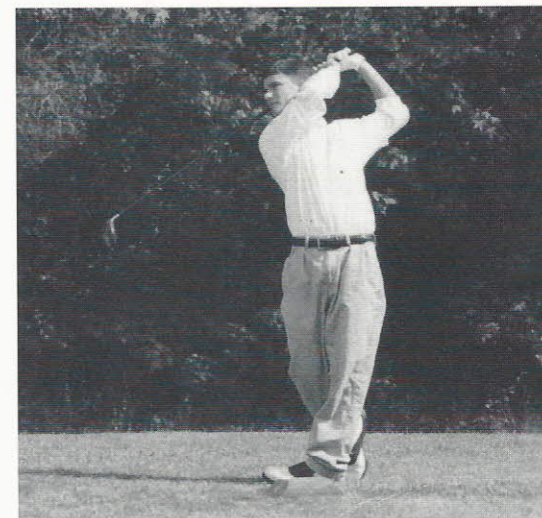
