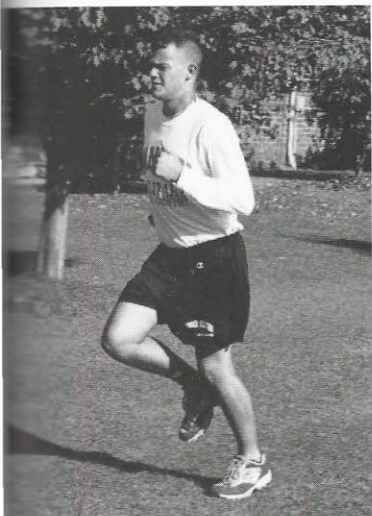

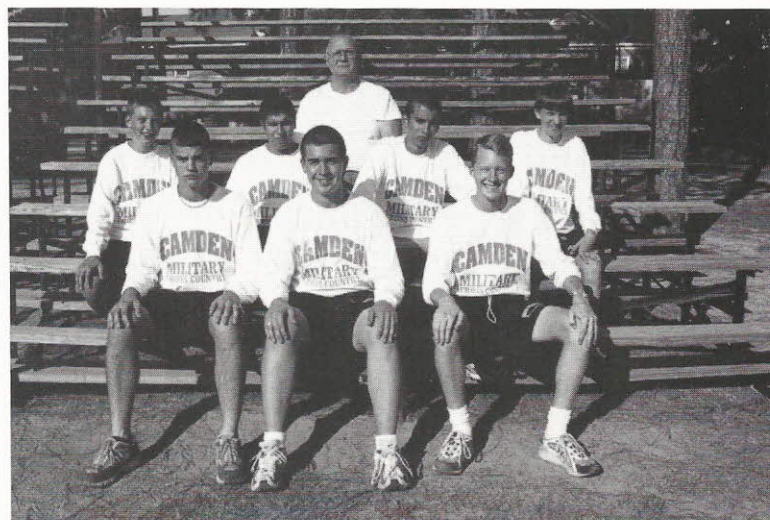


Senior team captain Jonathan Kaylor led Spartan cross-country runners during the 2000 season.

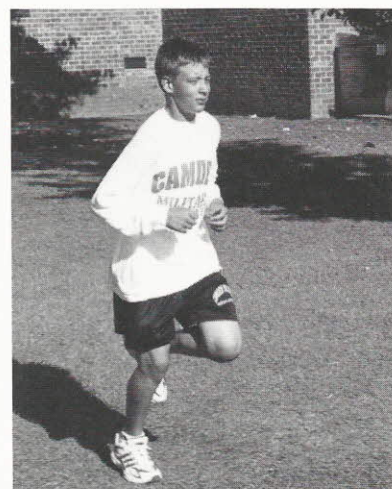


Most Valuable Runner, senior Perry Eubank has been a mainstay of the Spartan Team during his running career.

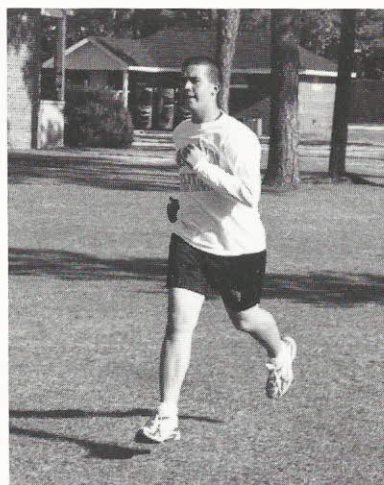


MP last year, Billy Orris received the Coach's Award in 2000 for his contribution to Spartan success.

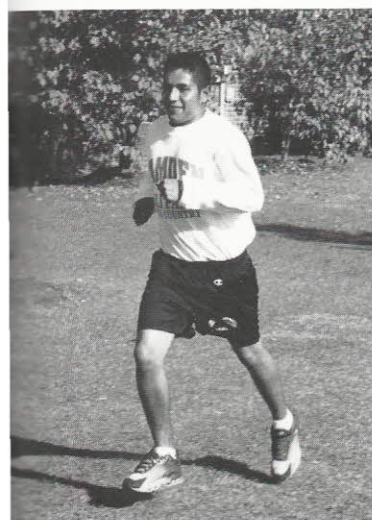


In his first year as a Spartan runner, eighth grader Kyle Markey is gaining valuable experience for the future.

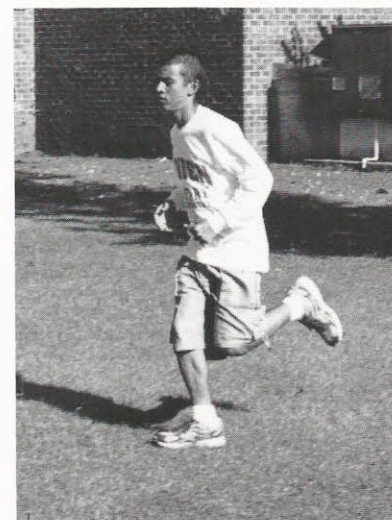
The efforts of senior James Denman and his teammates this year were characterized by hard work and determination.
