

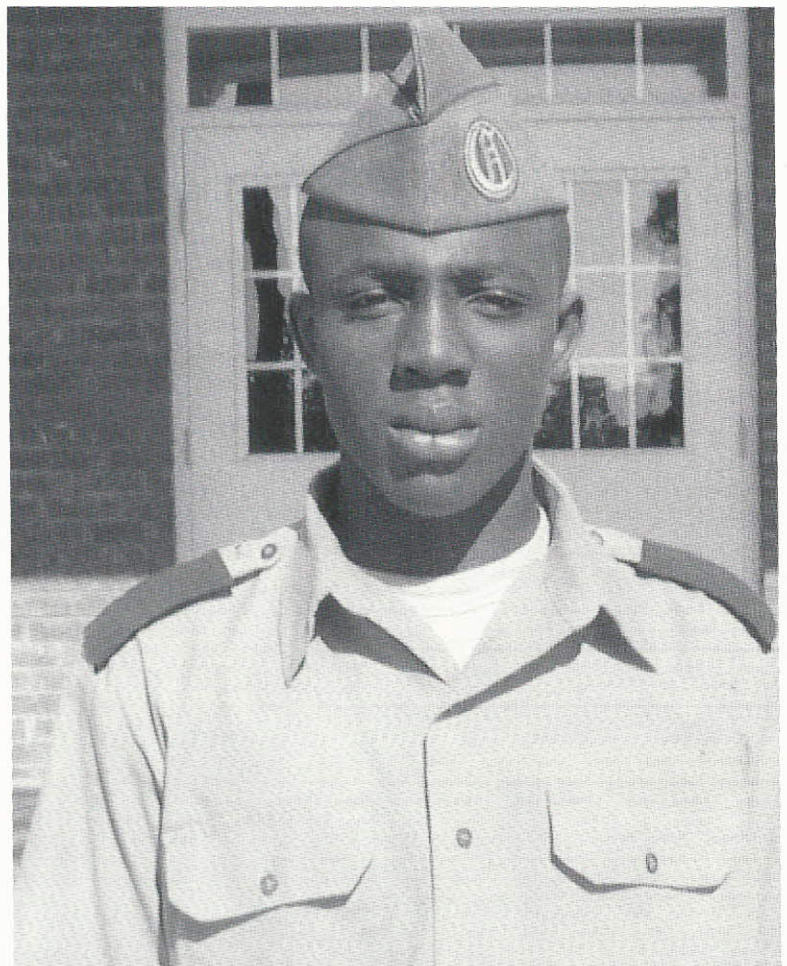


**LTC Armstrong, Commandant**
