

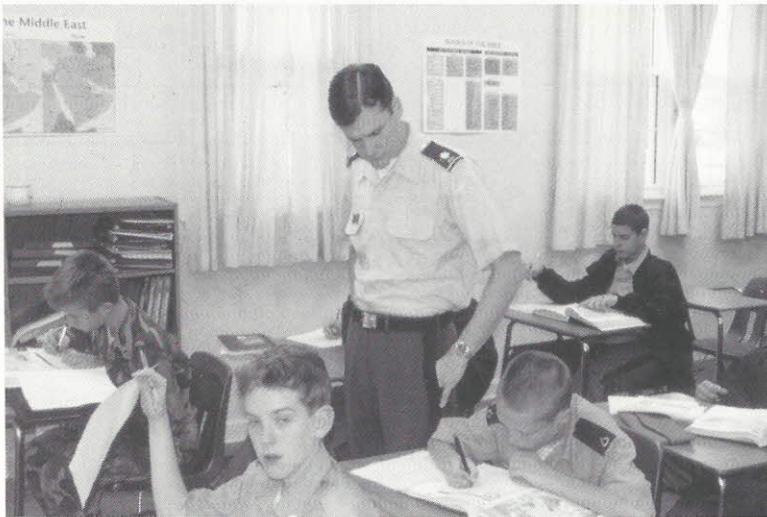
Individual Importance
