

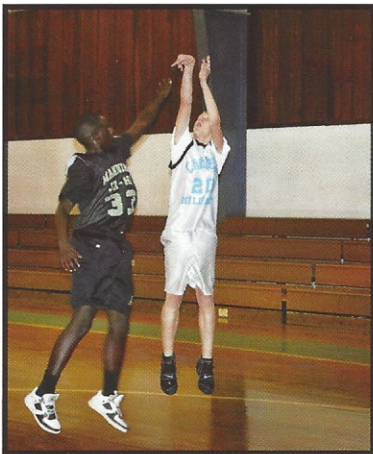
Middle School Basketball

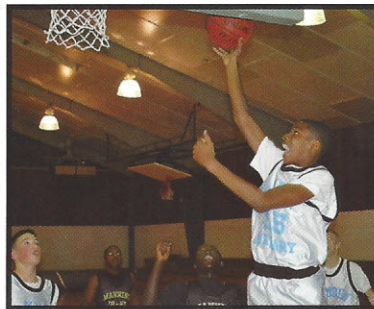

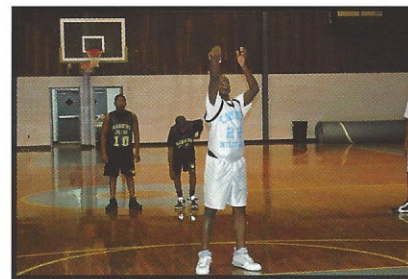

Dustin Brewington fires a short jumper in heavy traffic.



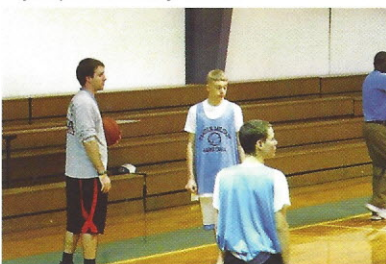
Josh Nelson goes to the basket.



Oscar Dixon shoots a free throw.



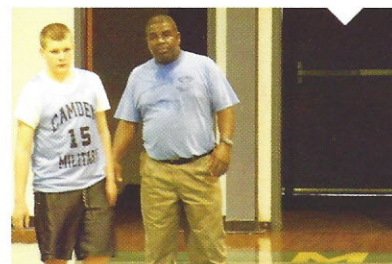
The team watches the game action.
