Today, the duties of the C.A.P. include homeland security, participating in search and rescue operations, as and, in some situations, serving as emergency couriers (e.g. organ deliveries).

In order to advance in the ranks, a junior member of C.A.P. must be tested both physically, as well as in written examinations.
