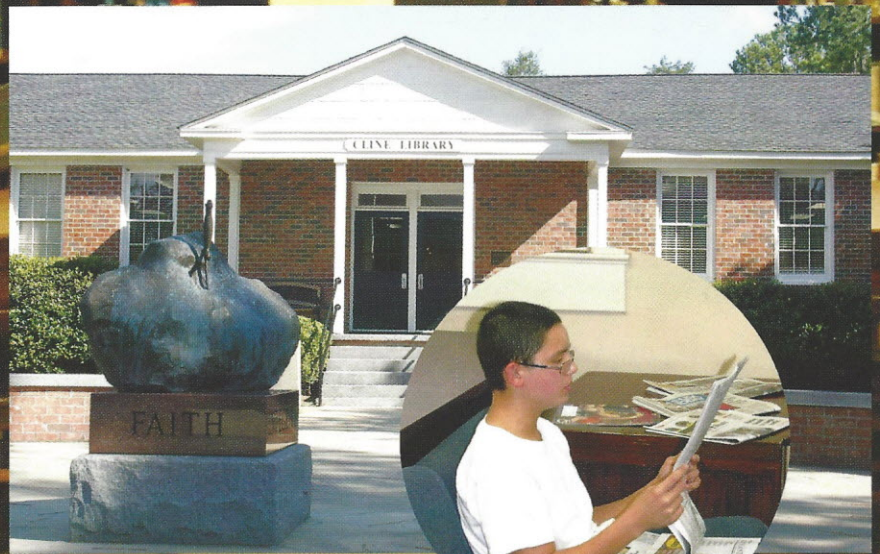
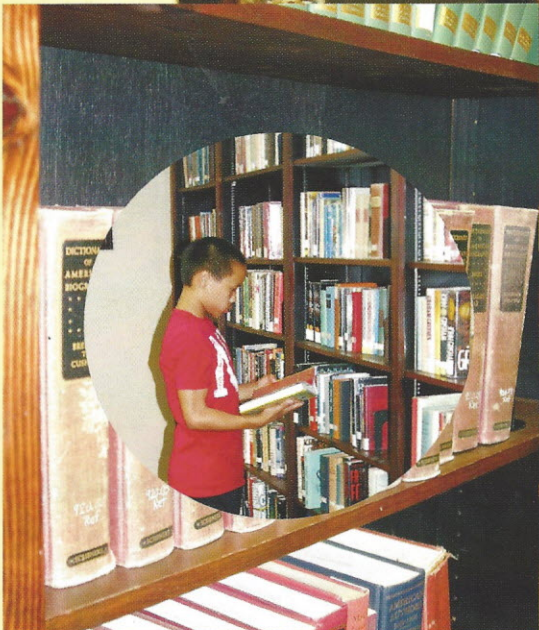
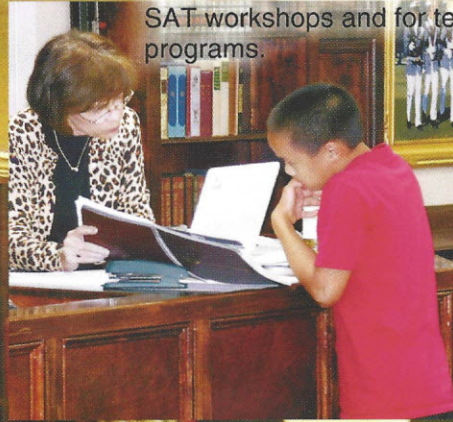
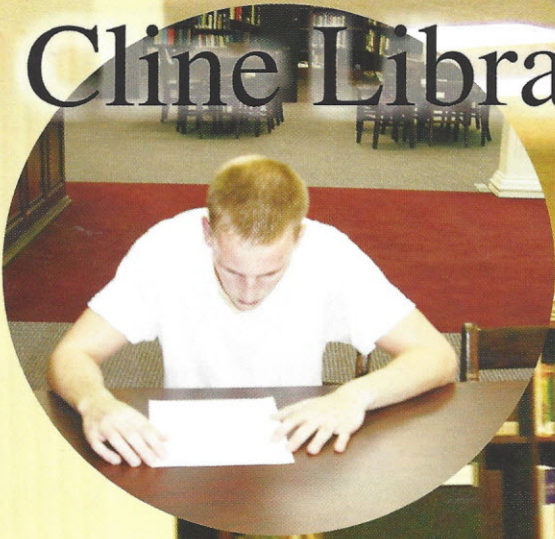


# Cline Library

The Cline Library was built in 1941 beside Woodward Airfield. In 1987 it was moved to its current location. The library shelves offer more than 8,000 titles. Nineteen computers afford cadets internet access, while three computers serve as the library's catalog. In addition to providing cadets a place to conduct research, it also serves as a venue for the CMA Book Club, Key Club, ACT and SAT workshops and for teachers' professional development programs.
