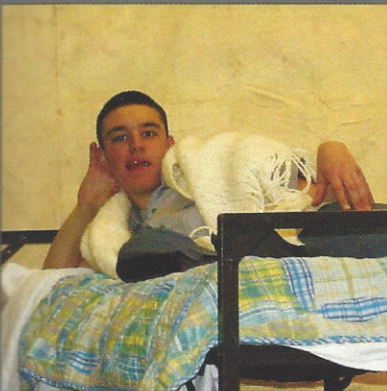
Plans for Future: Go to college in the United States, and study business. Then go back to China.
