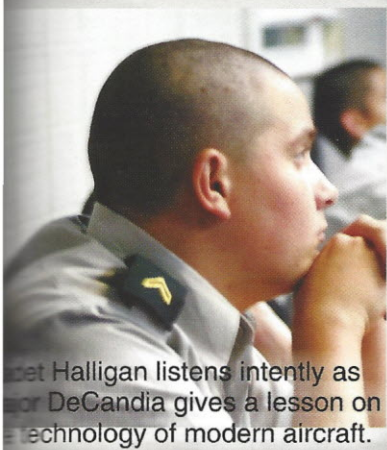
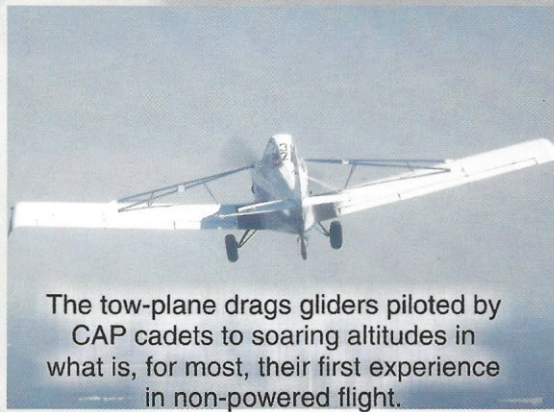


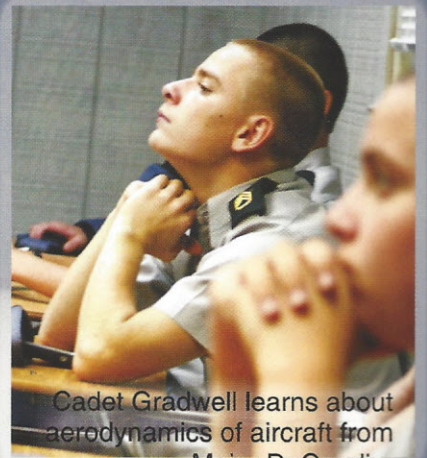

Cadet Gradwell learns about aerodynamics of aircraft from Major DeCandia.



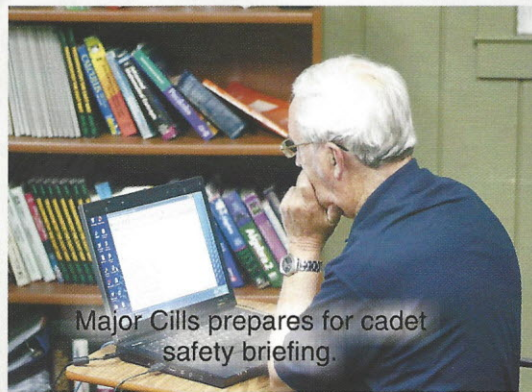
