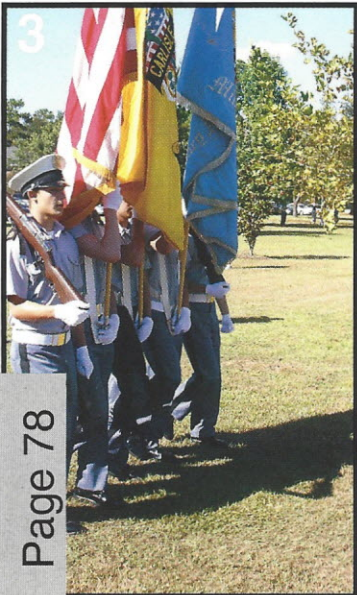


# Honor Parade For Major LePage & Ms. Kane
