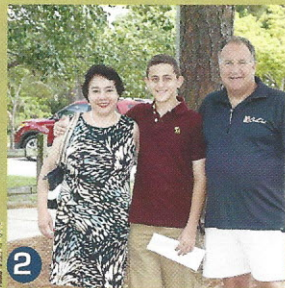

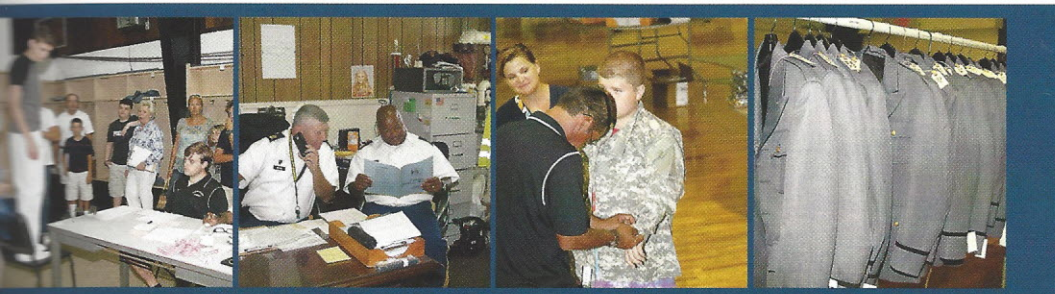

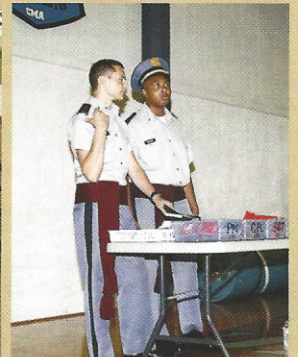
1. Santiago Villalobos helps Anthony Tuffo find his new barracks.
