



Martin Luther King Day

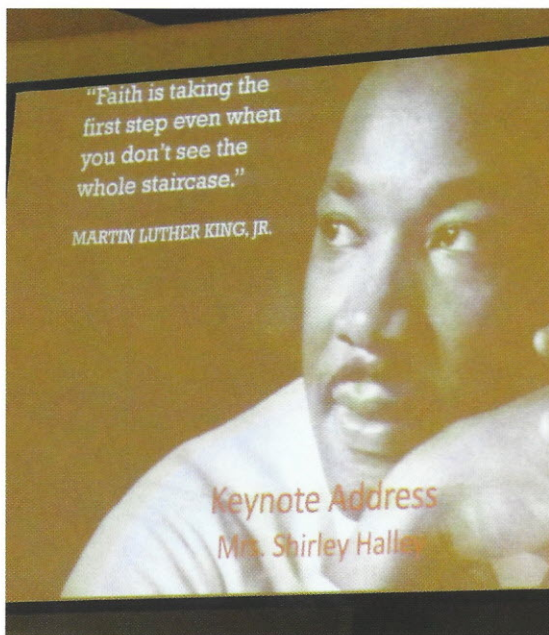
