

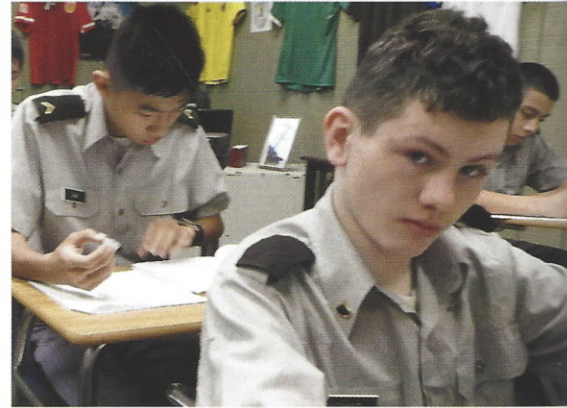
# momentous achievement

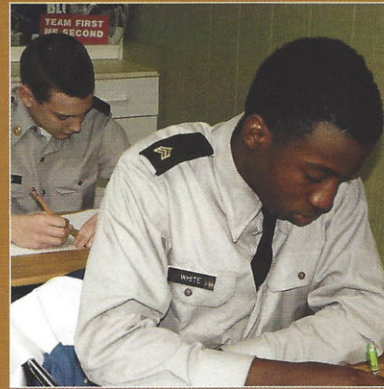
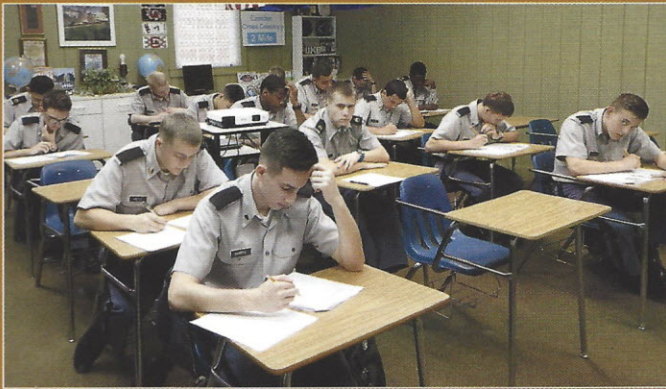
