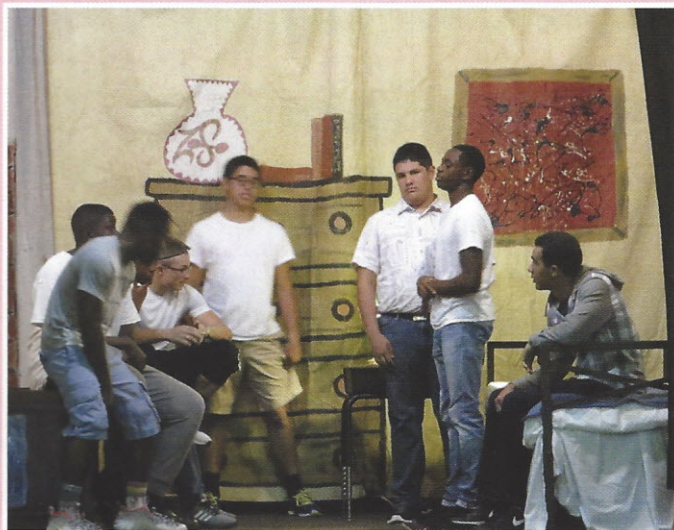
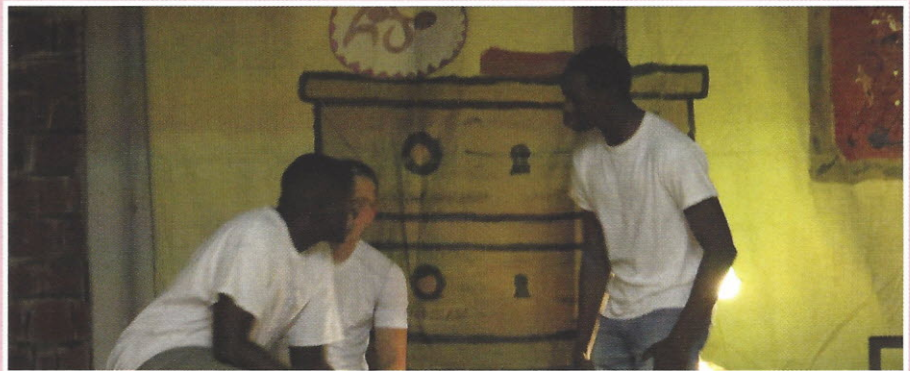
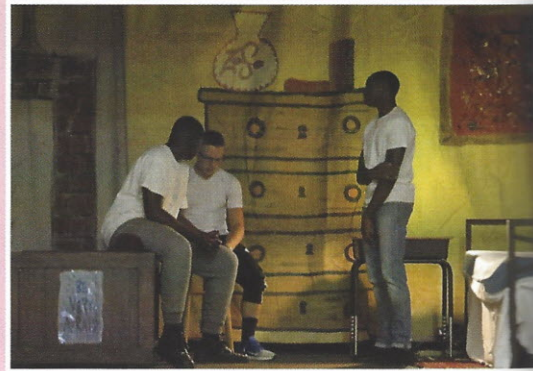


FINE ARTS
