

HONOR COUNCIL

One of the highest honors which can be bestowed upon a cadet at Carlisle is that of serving on the Honor Council. The Honor Council is composed of the Cadet Major, all Cadet Captains, and Capt. Thompson, faculty advisor.

It is the duty of this group to assign judicial punishment to those cadets who by their actions, have committed an offense which reflects discredit on the honor of the corps of cadets. When such a violation occurs the party is given a hearing by the Honor Council in which all evidence, witnesses, and their testimonies are brought forth, so that a just verdict may be reached. The verdict, along with punishment, is submitted to the Headmaster for approval.

As can readily be seen, a group such as this which has unlimited power in handling these matters, must be made up of capable and broad minded men of sound judgment.
