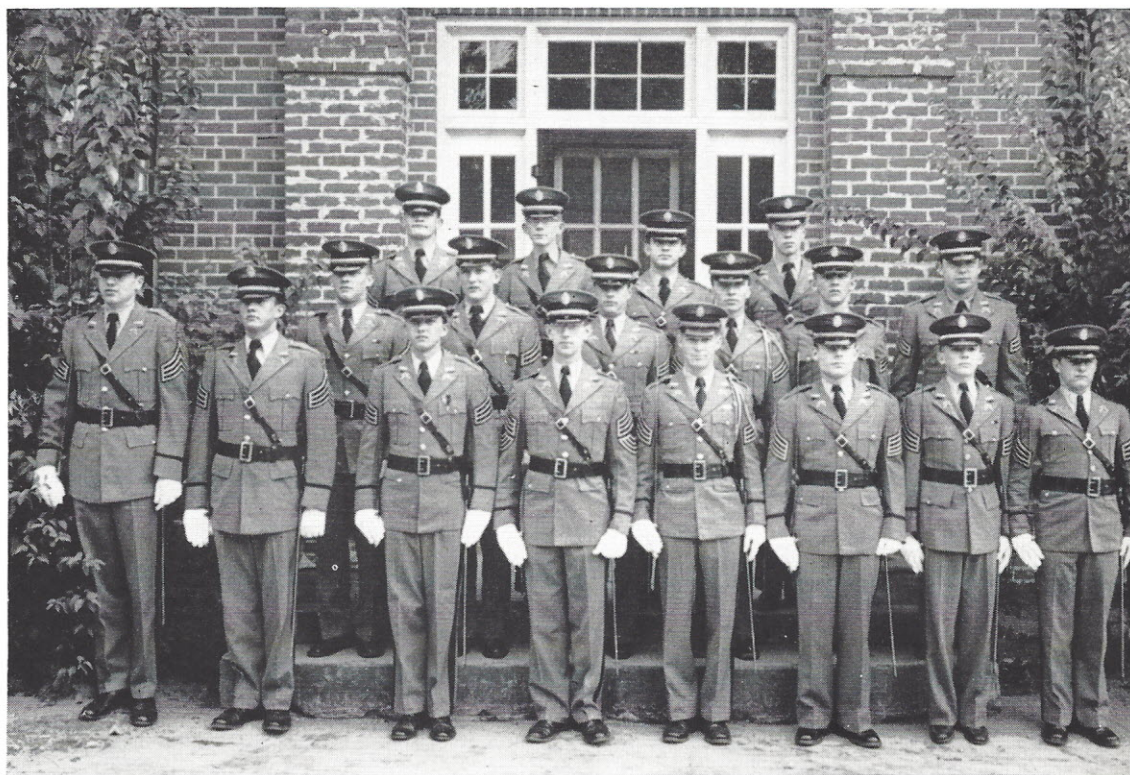


CROSS SABER CLUB
