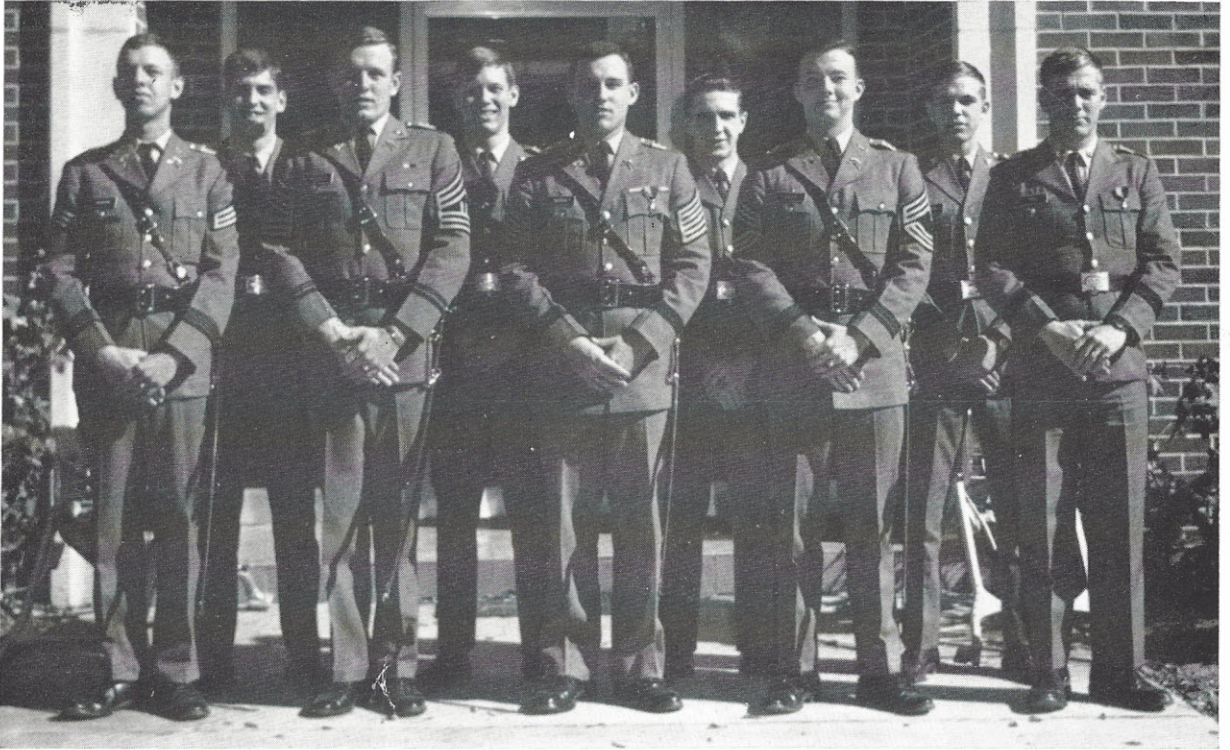


FIFTH YEARMEN
