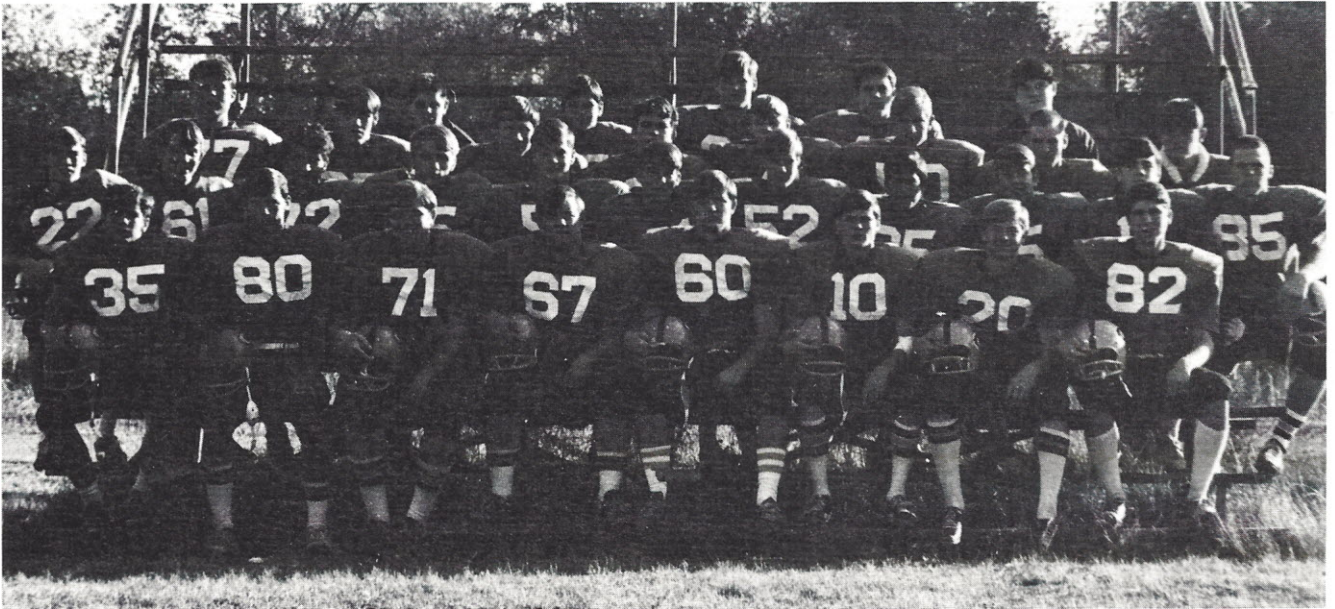


GOLDEN CYCLONES—1974
