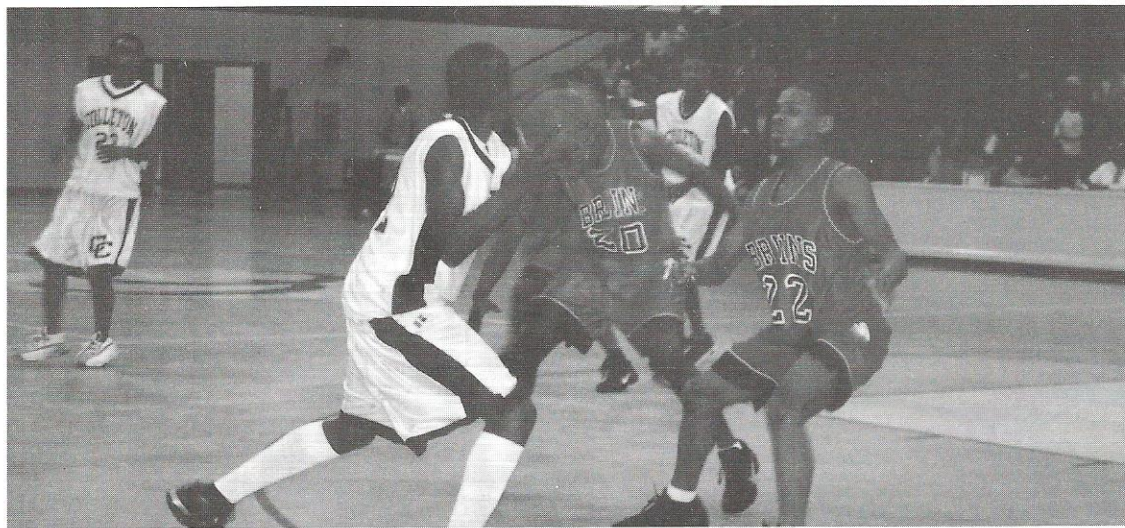
overcome many odds in order to prove their spirit and team talent.

When playing as a team, teamwork, communication, and dedication are all major factors to a successful season. This year, their goal was to make the playoffs.

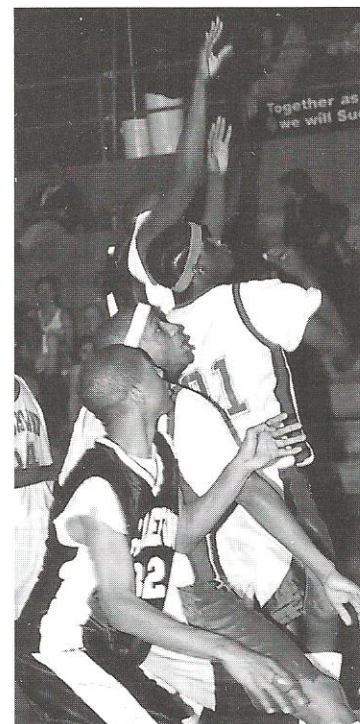
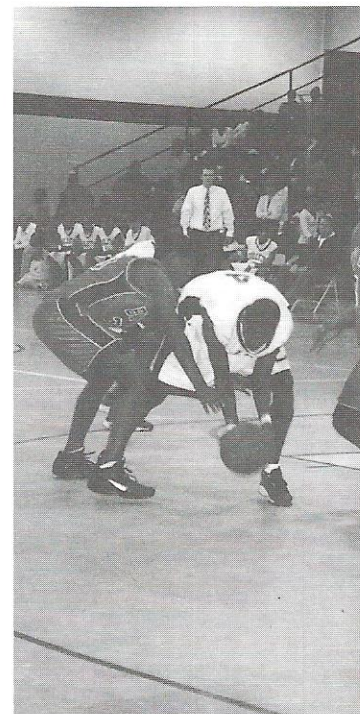
The junior varsity girls and boys seemed to work well with each other, almost as if

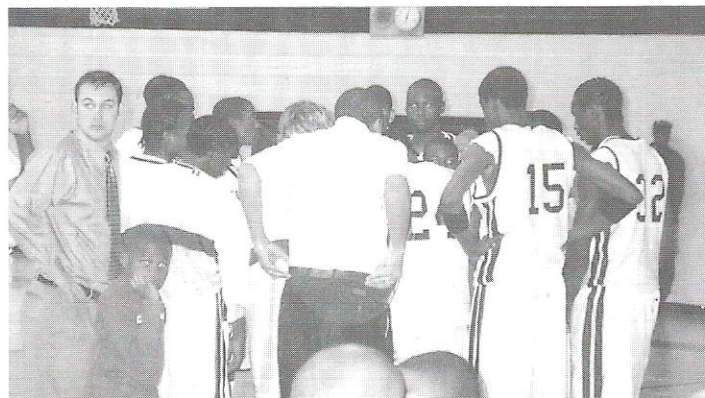


Where is all the help!! Former freshman, **Timothy Kelly** struggles to keep possession of the ball during the time of the game. While the opponent scrambles to get the ball.
