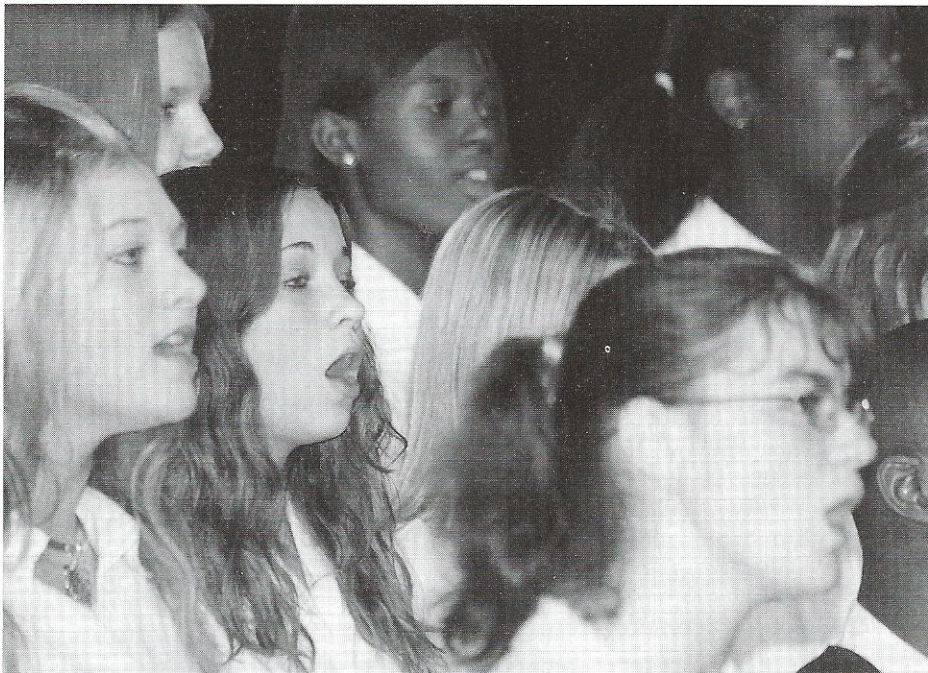
"Chorus meant trying my hardest and giving my best whether I was practicing or performing."
