

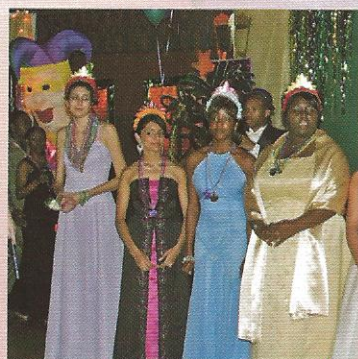


During an upbeat song, a group of girlfriends dance their feet off. Dancing was the main event at the prom.

2005 Princess Candidates

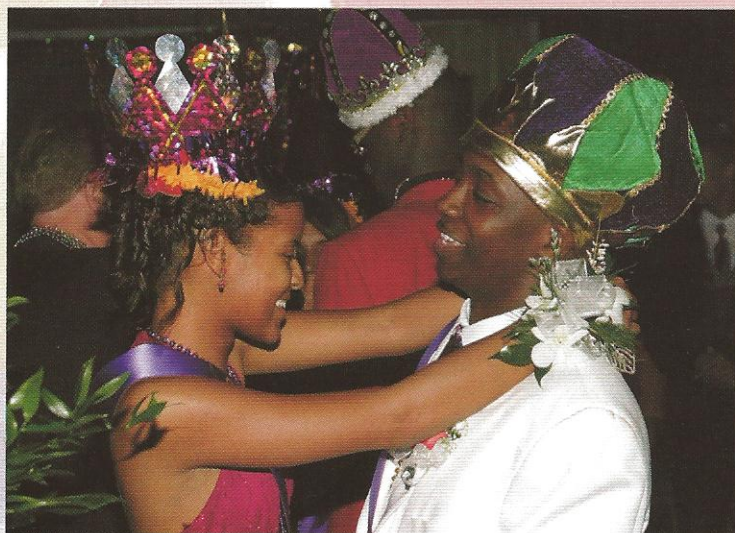
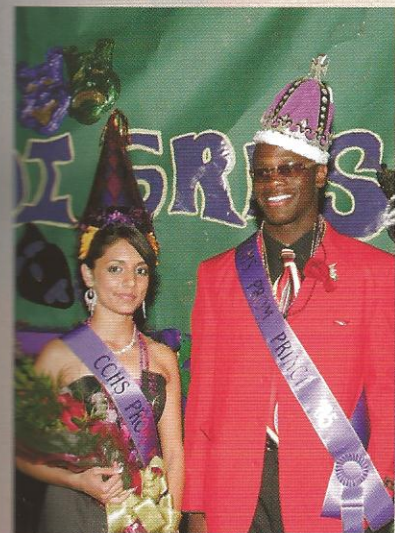
Proudly wearing beads donated by her friends, Former Junior Ashley Padgett (far left), waits nervously for the announcement of the 2005 Prom Princess.
