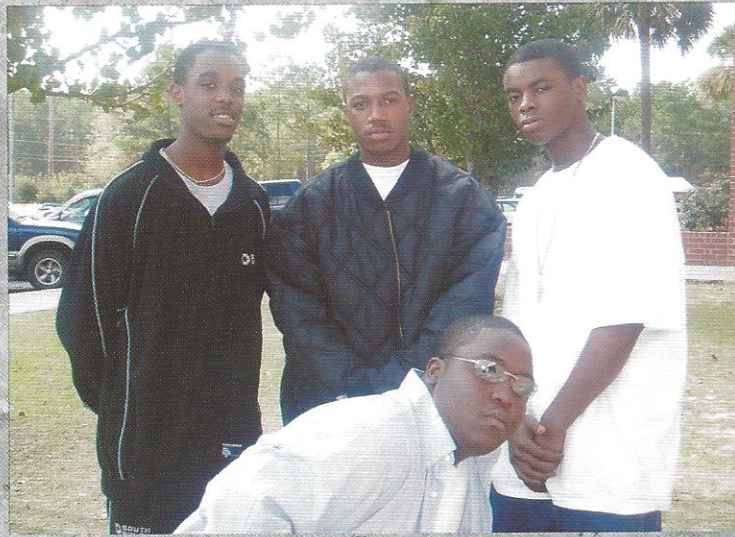
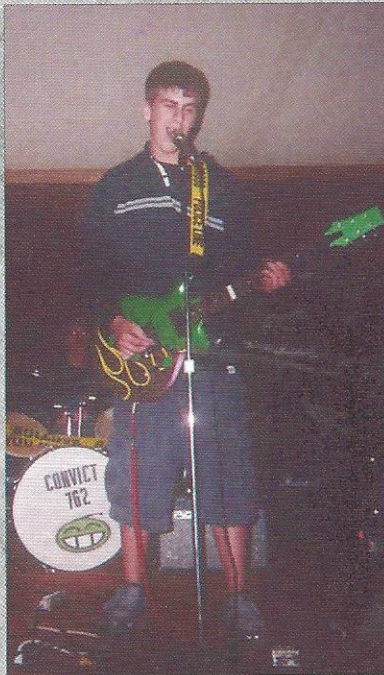


The members of O-Ficial pose for a picture after a busy practice. "I went from just watching them to being in the group and it has all been a great experience," Junior Gregory Grant said.

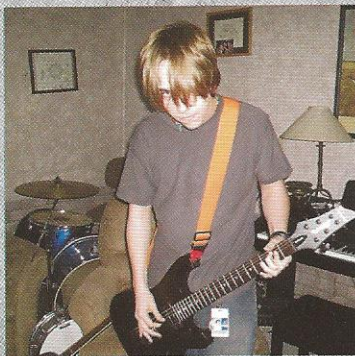
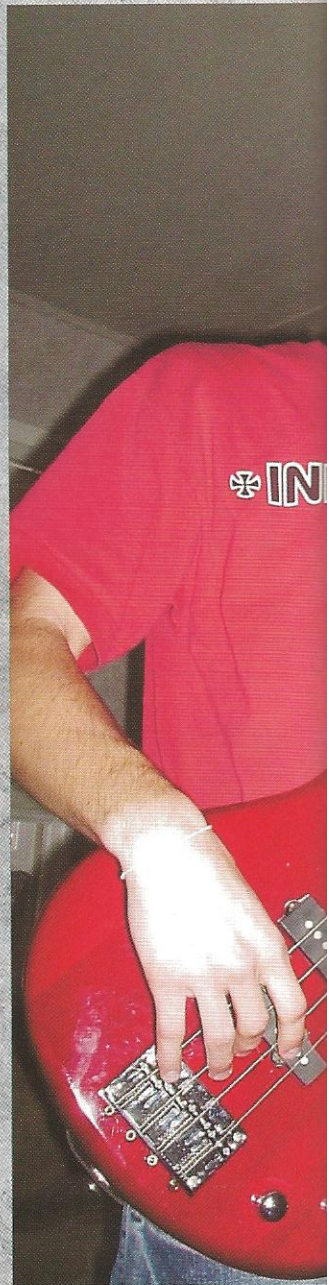


Star Search

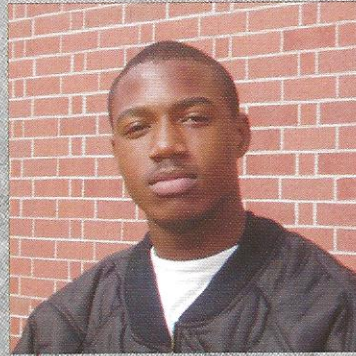

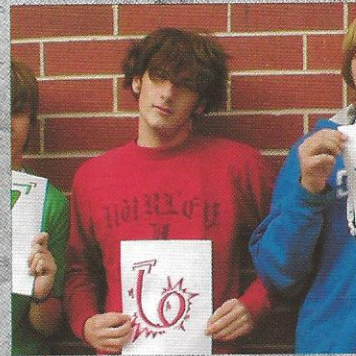
Senior Will Robbins
