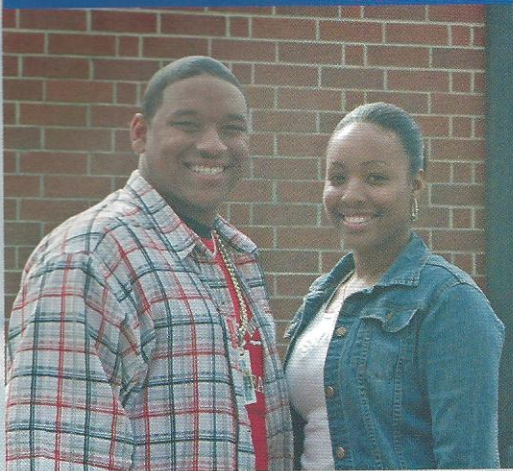


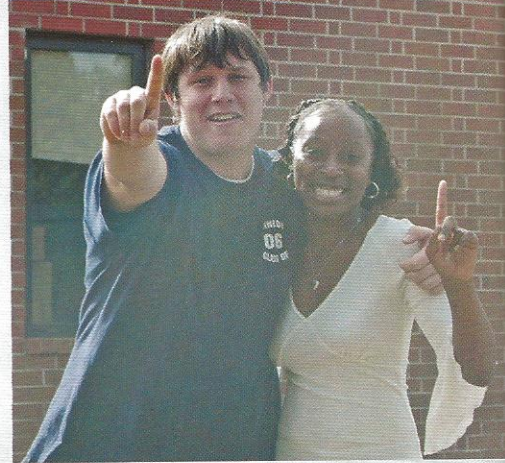
Best Smile

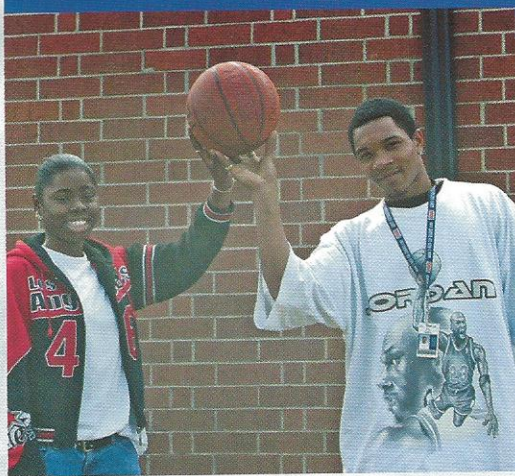
Senior Superlatives

"I was very excited to find out that I won. It's a great achievement being number one out of all of the other athletes," Eric Salley said. Natasha Gilliard loves playing basketball.

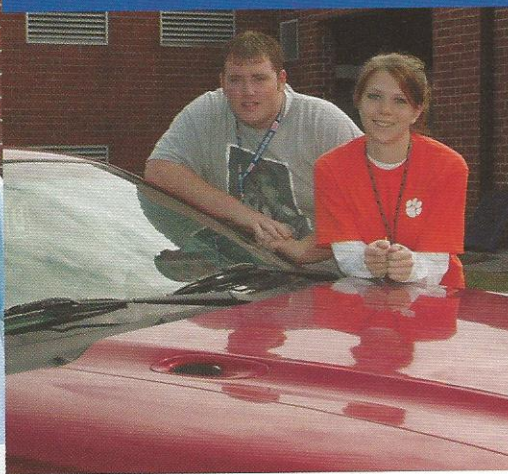
"At least now people know to stay out of my way," Victoria Harrison said. "Since ninth grade I've been through nine cars so I guess I kind of deserve this," David King said.
