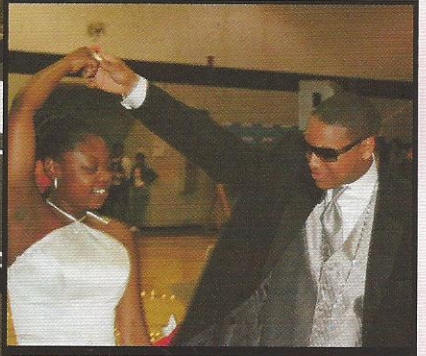
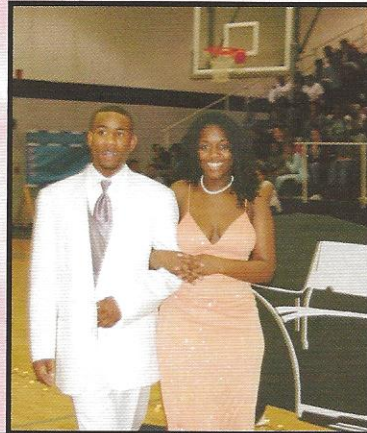


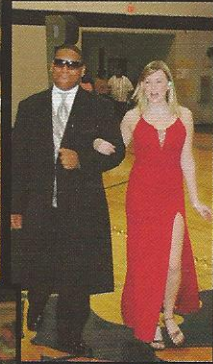
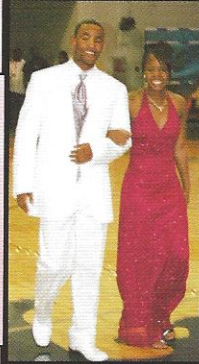
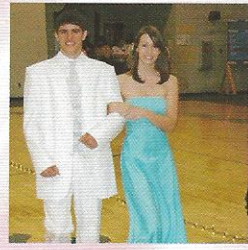
Prom

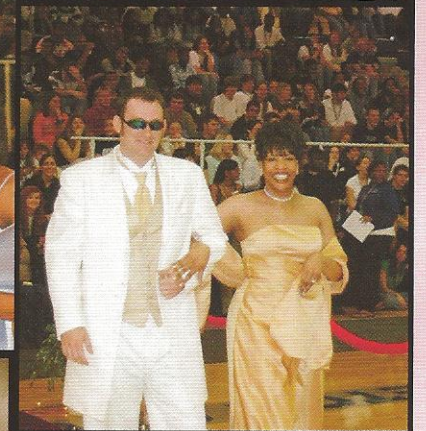
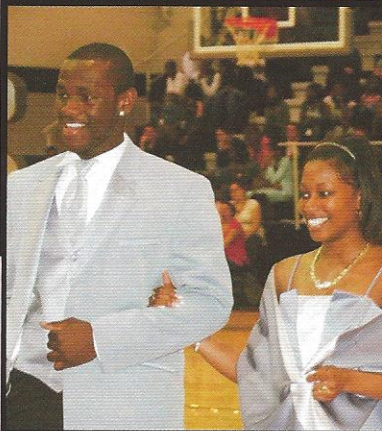
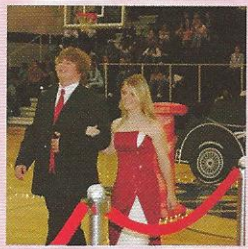
"Most of my friends were signing up so I decided to sign up. I think it was a great idea that I did. I had lots of fun," Junior Liza Lucas said.



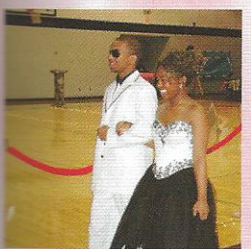
"To be or not to be," Novie Ulmer said as he showed off his tux for the crowd.
