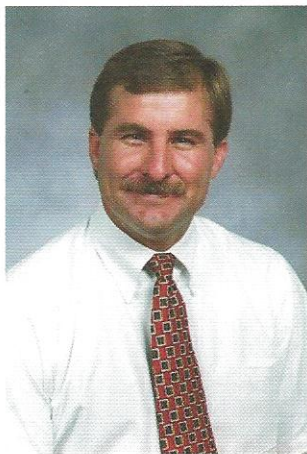


Principals

Vennie Mitchell

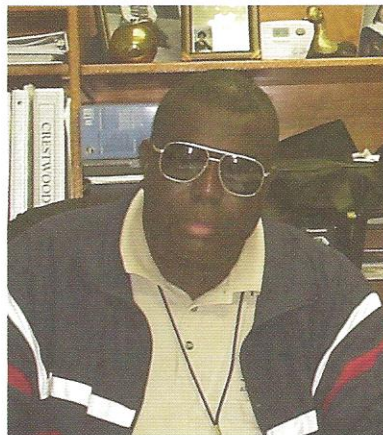
