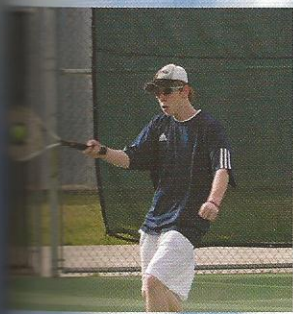




# Going For The Score

## Worth Hitting Through

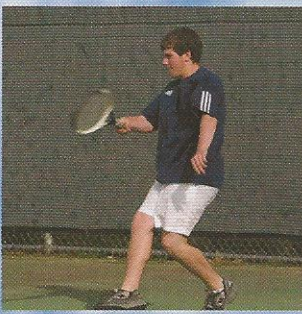

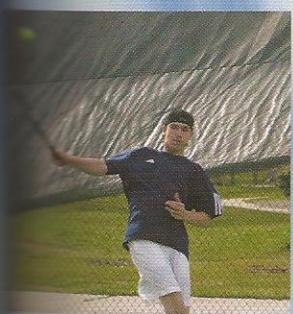
