

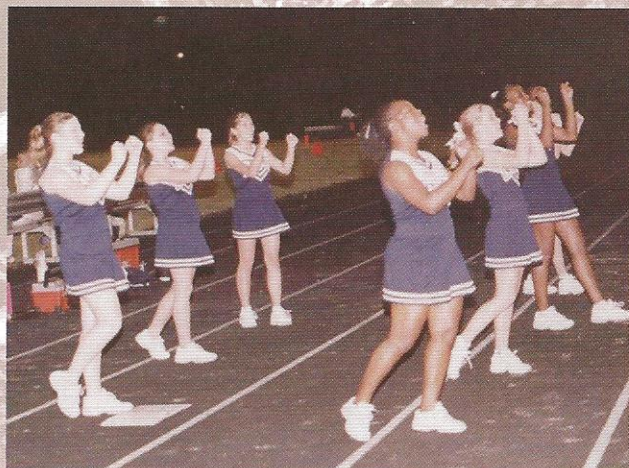
Stars on the Rise

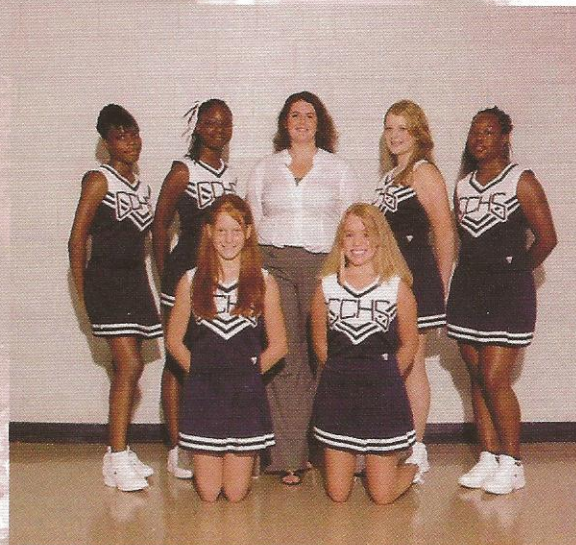
