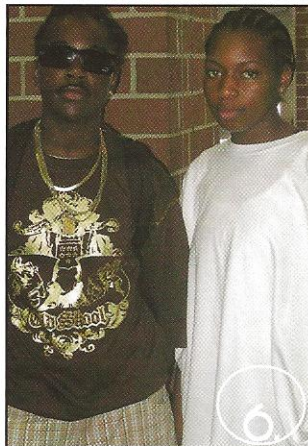
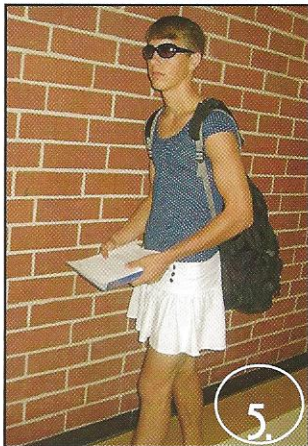
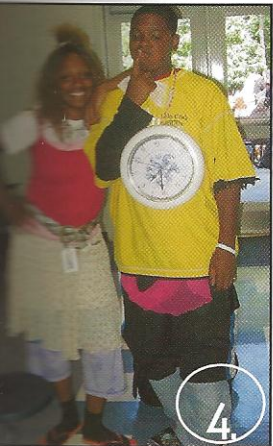
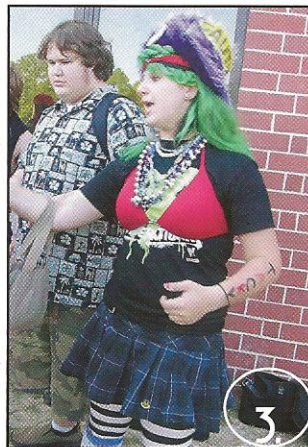
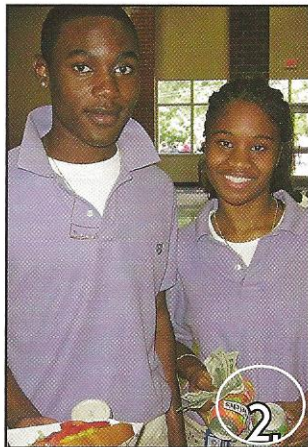


## We've Got Spirit! How About You?
