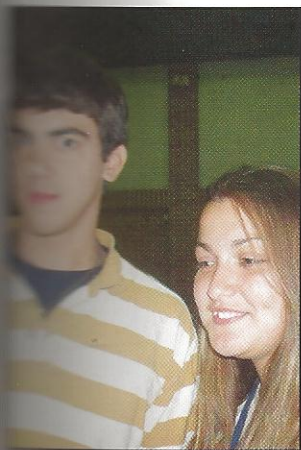

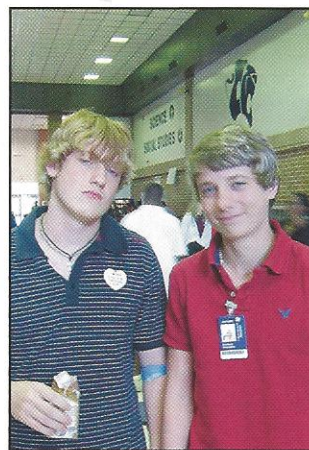

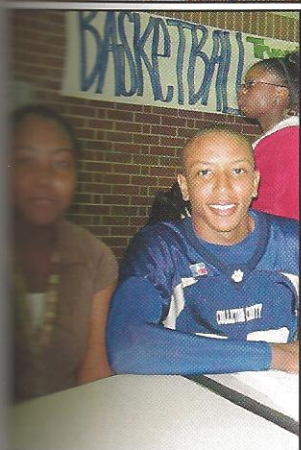

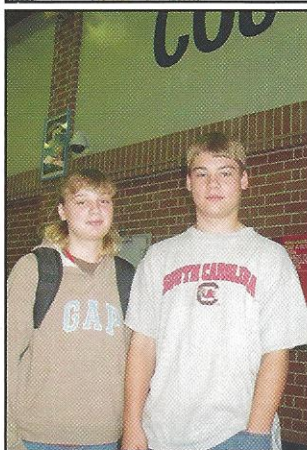
2. Senior Ebony Parker and brother Wayland Parker eat lunch together. "My brother Wayland and I get along really well," senior Ebony Parker said.



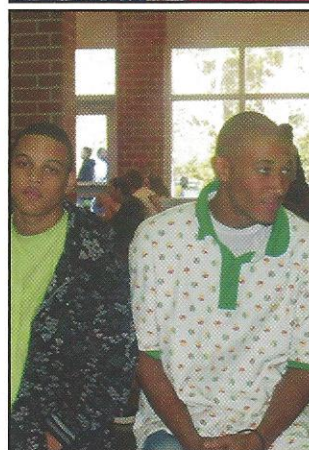
