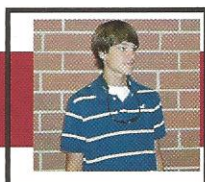
"Yes, support at games is important because it makes us play better," senior *Zach Singleton* said.



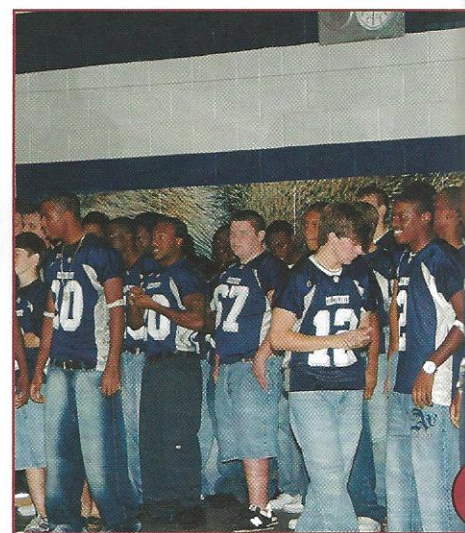
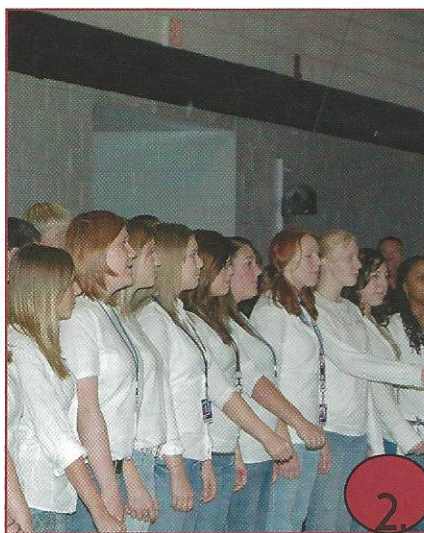
Ryan McGhie
