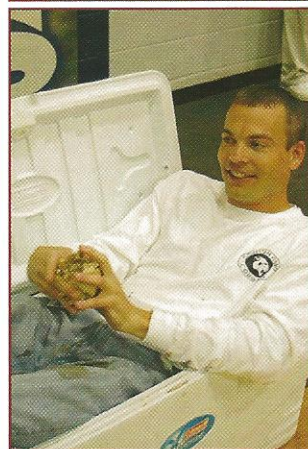
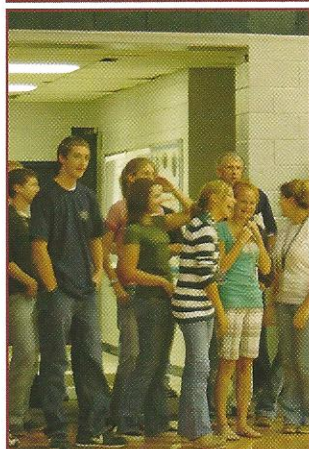
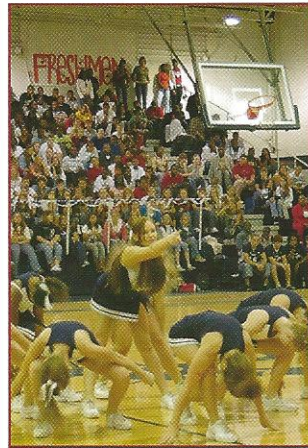
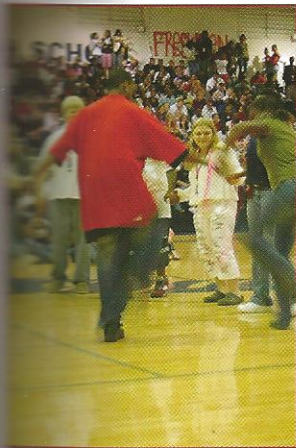


Pump It Up
