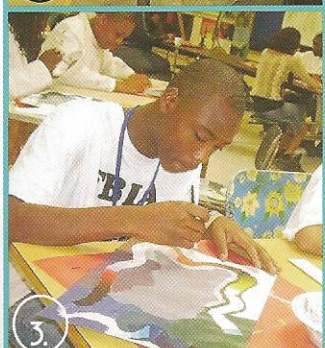
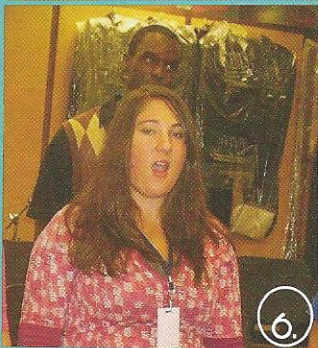
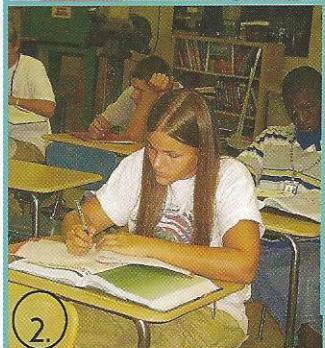
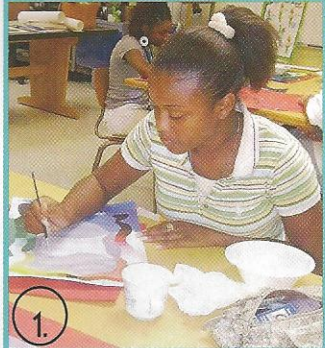
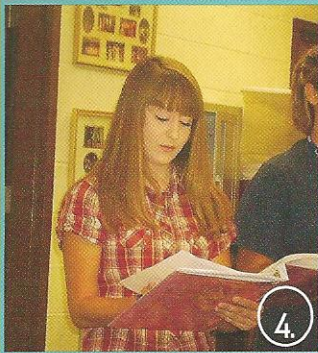


1. Sophomore Kasanta White concentrated while painting. "Some people may think that art is just drawing but it's more than that," White said.

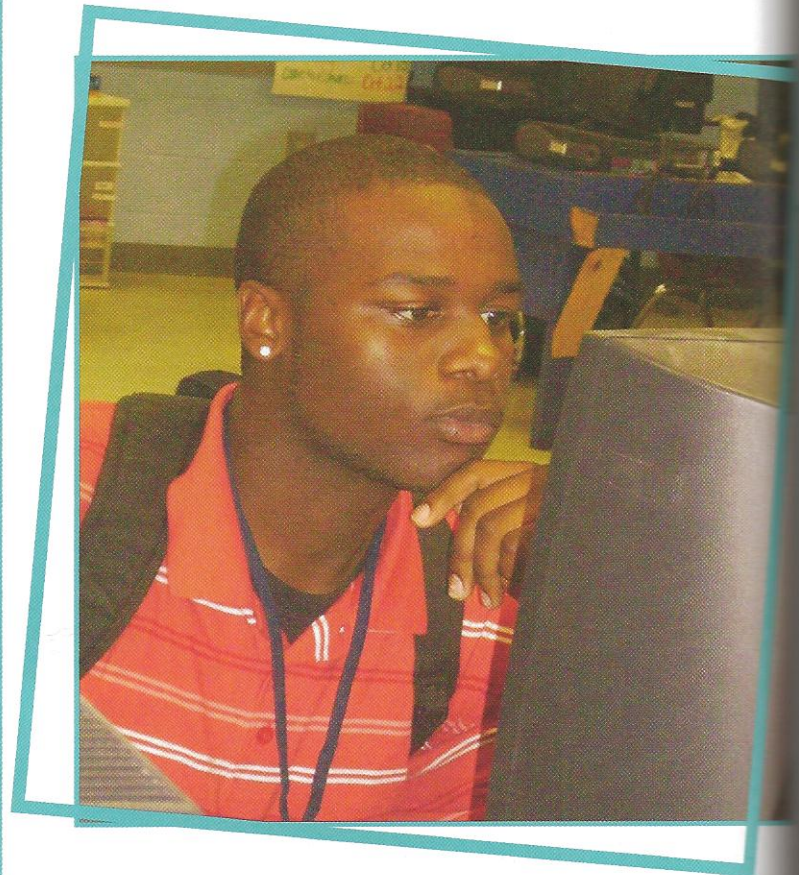
