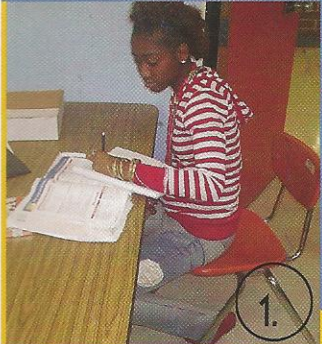


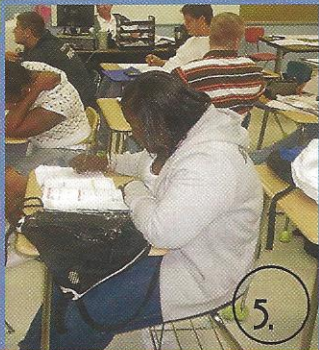
1. Junior MaTonya Ancrum did her math work. "I think that math is very interesting," MaTonya said.

 3. Freshman Ny'Aisha Way recorded the results from a lab. "I enjoy doing lab work to learn Algebra equations," Ny'Aisha said.



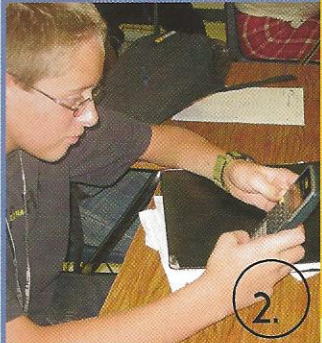
