"All I was thinking was Win! Win! Win! My mind was on the game." junior Ariel Snow said.

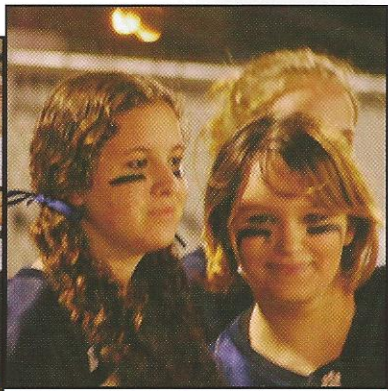
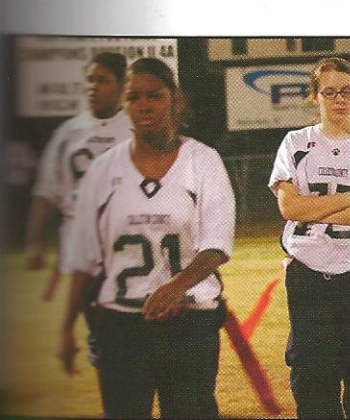


"I knew we were going to win because we had more people," Junior Dawana Dright said.

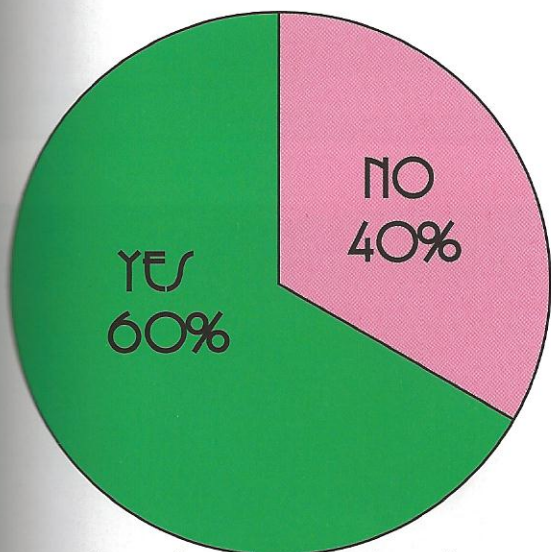
1. Synquetta Taylor was walking on the field about to play. "The last couple minutes of the game were my favorite because we knew we had won," junior Synquetta said.

2. Chelsea Cox was waiting her turn to get on the field and play some football. "I think the other team won because they played dirty," senior Chelsea said

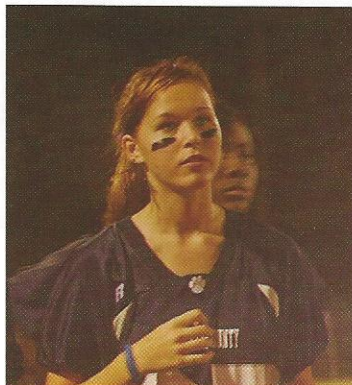
3. Jessica Killian is checking out the other team before she goes out to play. "The game was a lot of fun even though it turned physical. I would love to participate next year." junior Jessica said.
