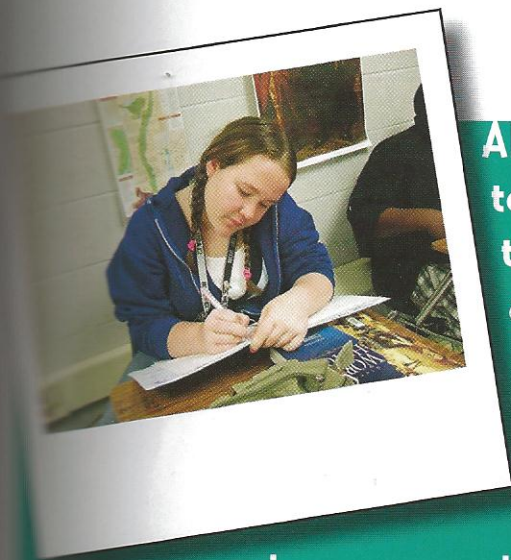

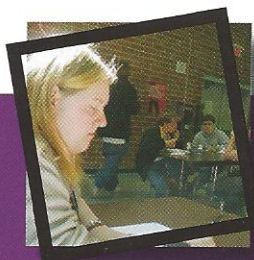

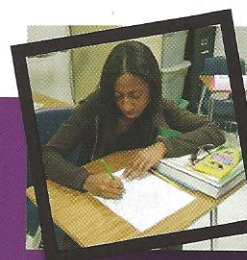
"I want to go to school to be a dancer because it helps me express myself and it takes a lot of stress off of my shoulders," freshman Madison Mauney said.
