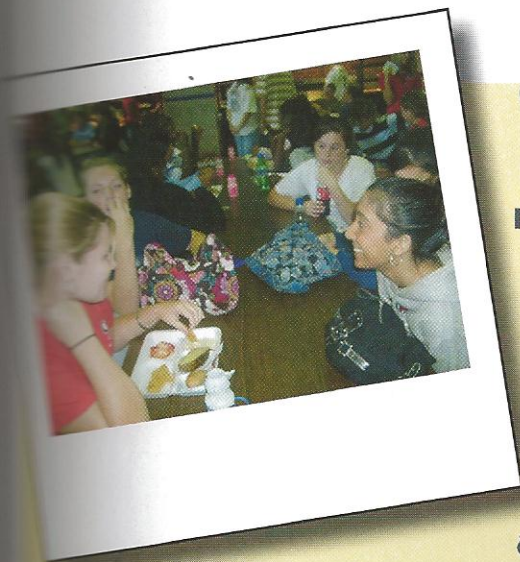
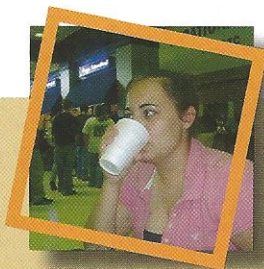
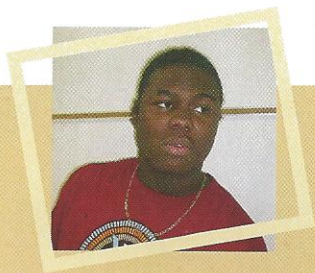


Who's Hungry?
