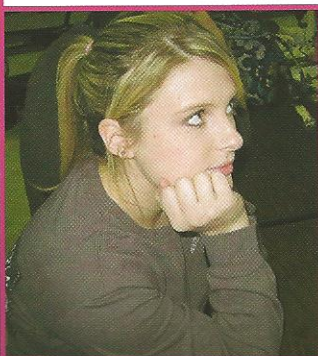

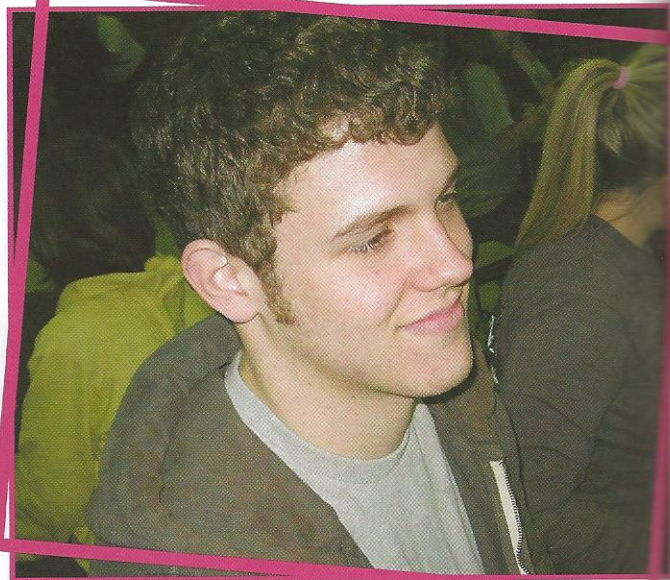
2. Senior Rebecca Wicker sits with friends at lunch. "I like that the classes are small because you can get more attention from the teacher," Wicker said.
