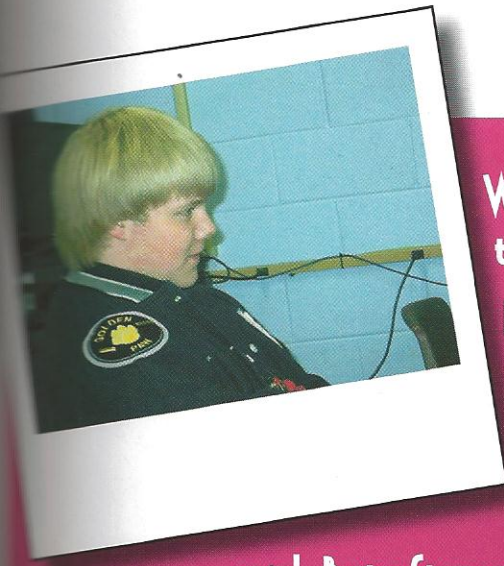


Smarties
