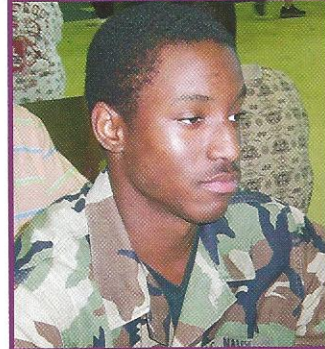
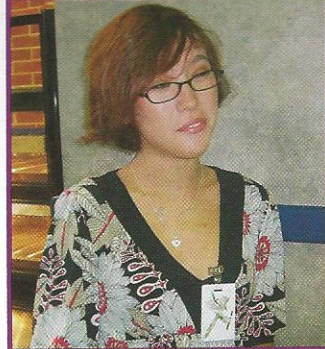
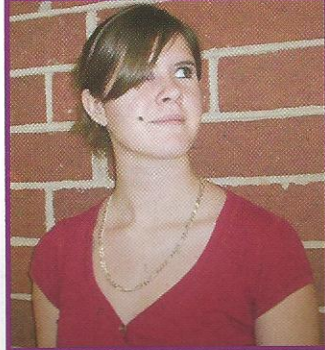
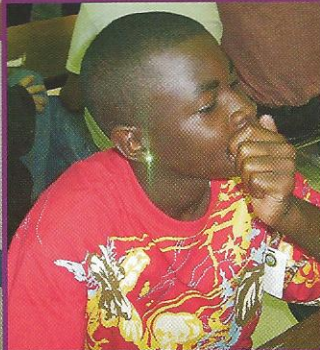
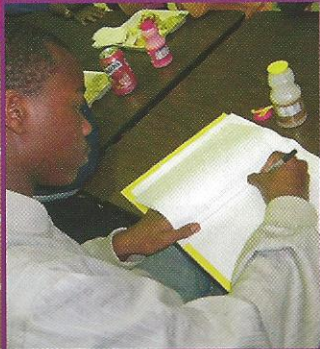
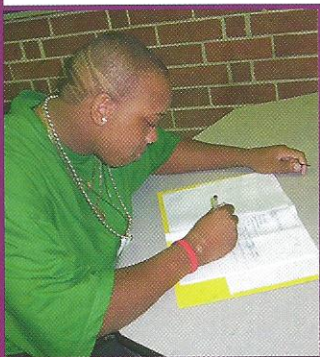


1. Junior Maley Deam hung out in the hallway between classes. "I like to write, I get to use my imagination," Maley said.

3. Sophomore Taurean Dligan dazed off while sitting at the lunch table. "I don't like reading because it is boring," Taurean said.

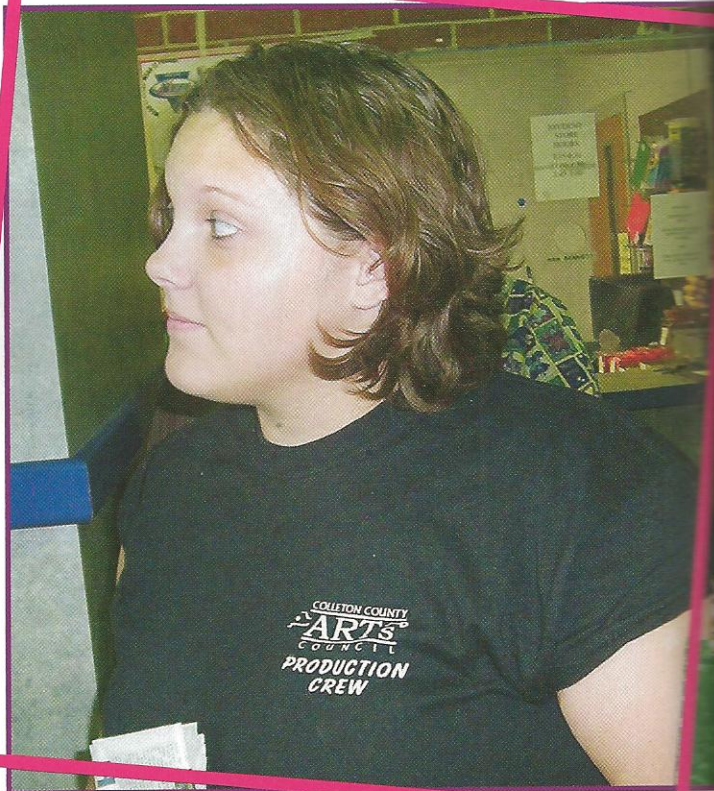


1. Junior Drandon Wesley was writing an essay at lunch. "Summer reading is a waste of time," Drandon said.
