

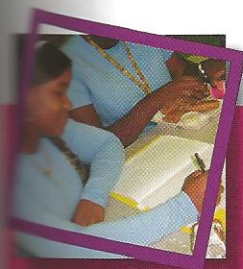
The Reading Rainbow

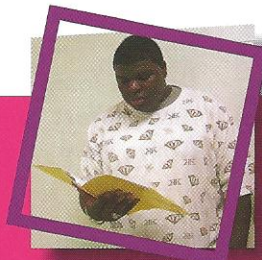
