"I enjoyed volleyball because it was fun and interesting. I was doing something new and got to meet new people," sophomore Darlen Greenwell said.



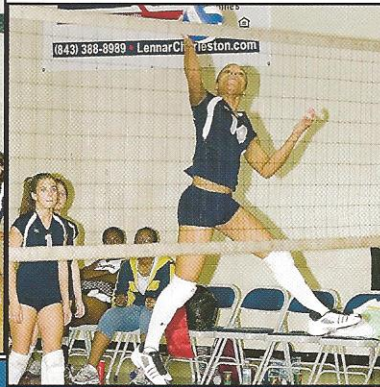
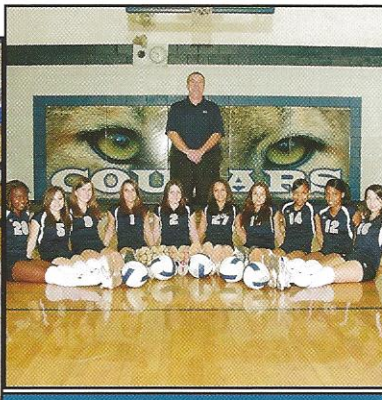
